

SCS COVID Protocols

(Based on CDC guidelines) *updated March 2024

Updated CDC Guidance

	IF	THEN
1	Your child has symptoms of COVID (fever, cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea)	Test immediately. If the test is negative and your child has been symptom free for 24 hours, your child can return to school.
2	Your child has come in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID	May return to school. Getting tested 5-7 days after exposure and wearing a mask is recommended.
3	If your child tests positive for COVID	Stay home for 24 hours. You may rerun to school if both are true: • Your symptoms are getting better overall, and • You have not had a fever (and are not using fever-reducing medication). While it is not required, the CDC recommends wearing a mask around others through day 10.
4	If a member of your household has tested positive for COVID or is awaiting a COVID test.	Your child may return to school as long as they have no symptoms. Getting tested 5 days after exposure and wearing a mask is recommended.

*This is subject to change, based on CDC guidelines and current state of pandemic.

SCS Mitigation Strategies:

- 1. SCS will continue to optimize air handling and ventilation practices, which includes increased outside air intake and improved air filtration.
- 2. We will continue to encourage thorough hand washing and will regularly disinfect classrooms and common areas.
- 3. Electrostatic spraying will take place on a weekly basis.

Additional SCS Protocol Information:

- 1. Per CDC recommendation, SCS encourages students and staff to get vaccinated. COVID-19 vaccination helps protect eligible people from getting severely ill with COVID-19.
- 2. Only individuals who test positive are required to isolate (not attend school).
- 3. The wearing of masks by students and staff will be optional, but recommended.
- 4. If your child needs to quarantine, there will not be live Zoom sessions and we do not have a remote learning option. Please reach out directly to your child's teacher for their work for the duration of their quarantine.
